- Once new and charged batteries have been installed in the transmitter and car, turn the car and transmitter on for automatic pairing!
- If the car turns off while playing, first check the on/off switch at the bottom of the car and make sure it didn't get switched to the "off" position while playing. Check to make sure the battery is fully charged and the transmitter has new batteries
- If the wheel at the top becomes loose, please replace the wheel and metal pole with the ones provided in the box




