Kids Constellation Globe Care & Use Guide

Thank you for choosing our **Illuminated Constellation Globe!** This easy-to-use educational globe is designed to spark curiosity about our planet and the stars. Please follow the guide below for safe use and proper care.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX:

- World Globe LED constellation light
- Power cord (plugs into globe base and wall outlet)
- Illustrated constellation booklet

HOW TO USE:

- 1. Place Safely: Set the globe on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- **2. Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into the port on the globe's base, then into a standard wall outlet.
- **3. Light It Up:** Use the inline switch to turn on the LED light. View constellations clearly in a dim or dark room.
- **4. Explore:** Rotate the globe 360° to learn about continents, countries, and Earth's features during the day—then discover 88 constellations when the light is on.
- **5. Learn More:** Use the included booklet and optional app to enhance your child's learning experience.

LED LIGHT INFO:

- Type: Built-in LED bulb
- Use: Functions as a nightlight or desk lamp
- Note: If the light stops working or dulls, unplug the globe and replace

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe gently with a soft, dry or lightly damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or submerge in water.
- **Cord Safety:** Avoid pinching or bending the power cord. Unplug when not in use for long periods.
- For Indoor Use Only: Keep away from moisture and direct sunlight.

IF THE BASE FEELS LOOSE:

If the globe feels wobbly, simply hold the metal pole (support arm) with one hand and gently twist the round base with the other hand to tighten it securely.

SAFETY TIPS:

- Adult supervision recommended for children under 8
- Not a toy for rough play intended for educational and decorative use
- Keep away from water and extreme heat

FUN WAYS TO USE THE GLOBE TOGETHER:

1. DAY & NIGHT DISCOVERY

- **During the Day:** Ask your child to find where you live, then look up other countries or continents. You can play "Find the Country" or "Spin and Point" for quick geography games.
- At Night: Dim the lights and turn on the globe to explore the stars.
 Ask, "Can you find Orion?" or "How many constellations do you see?"

2. STORYTIME WITH THE STARS

• Use the constellation booklet to tell short stories or myths about the stars (e.g., the legend of Pegasus or Cassiopeia). Encourage your child to invent their own constellation stories!

3. SPIN & LEARN GAME

- Take turns spinning the globe and wherever it stops, find out:
 - What continent or country is it?
 - Is it hot or cold?
 - What animals might live there?
 - What's one thing you'd like to visit?
